After much preparation, The Ohio State University Campylobacter Research Study has now begun to accept participants. The study delivers food safety information about *Campylobacter jejuni* and the risk for bacterial diarrhea illness in children ages 1 to 9, especially during the summer when risk increases. This study focuses on chicken and turkey products that are so often the main ingredient of summertime foods.
