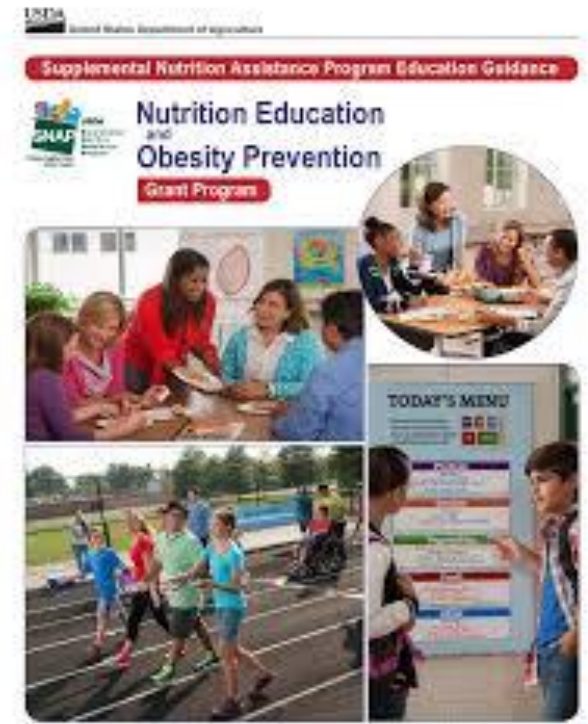

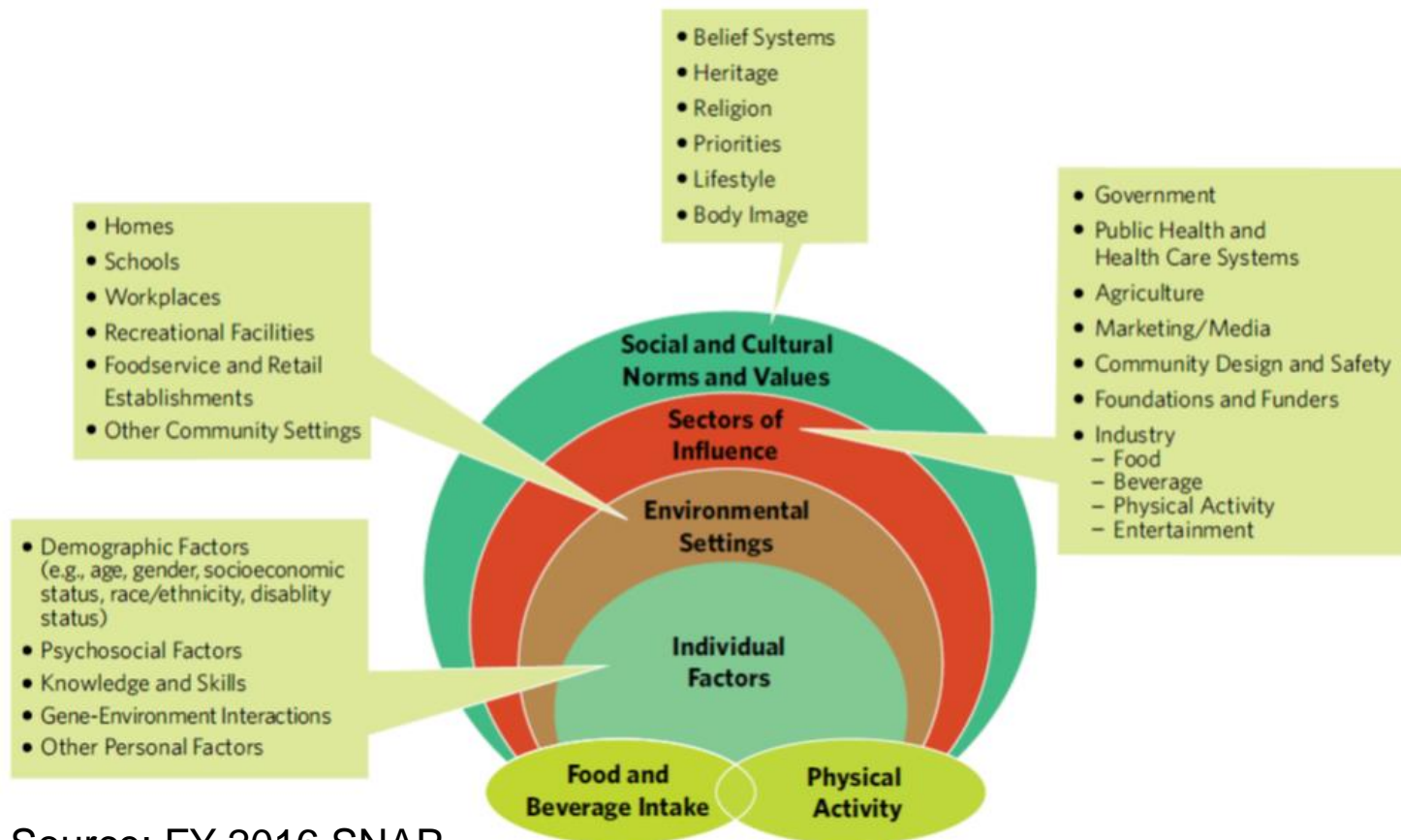
The FY 2016 SNAP Education Plan Guidance

- Community or public health based approaches to obesity prevention



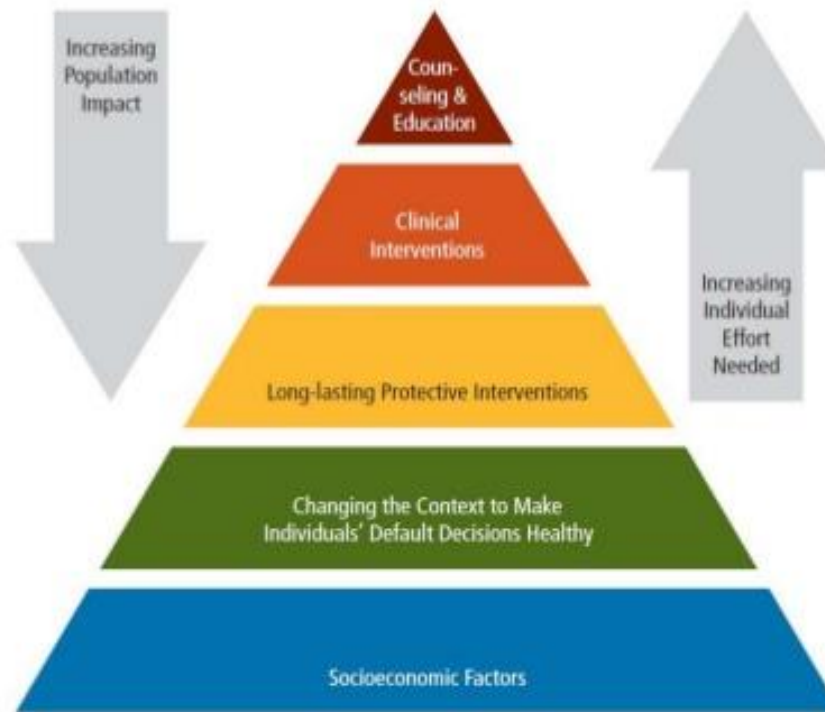
The Social Ecological Framework

Barriers and Challenges to PSEC

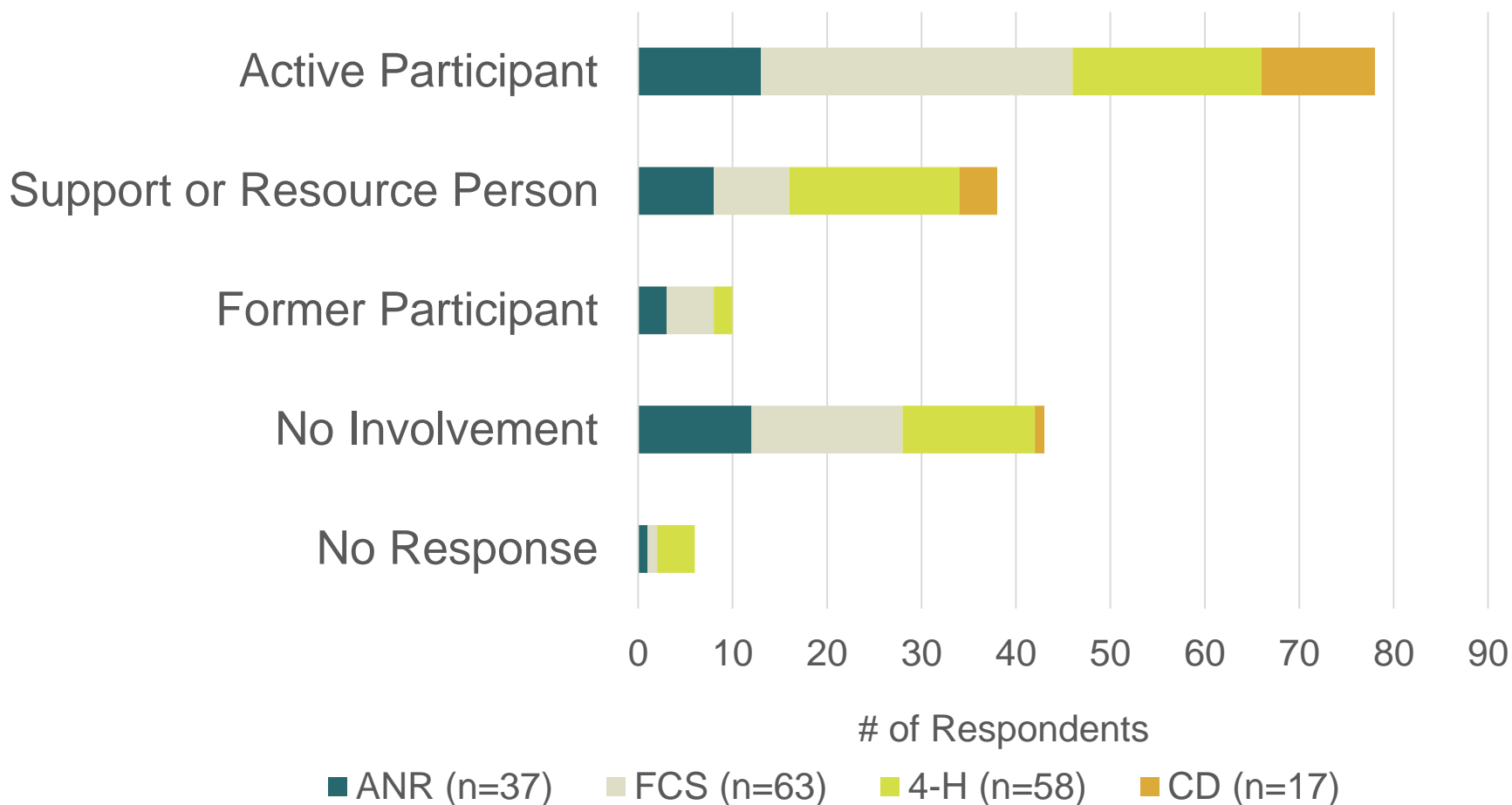
- Not sure what PSEC is
- Not sure who to work with
- Not sure how to build partnerships without appearing as though “taking over”
- Not sure how to report/evaluate PSEC efforts
- Lack of financial support

Community Coalitions: Vehicles for PSEC

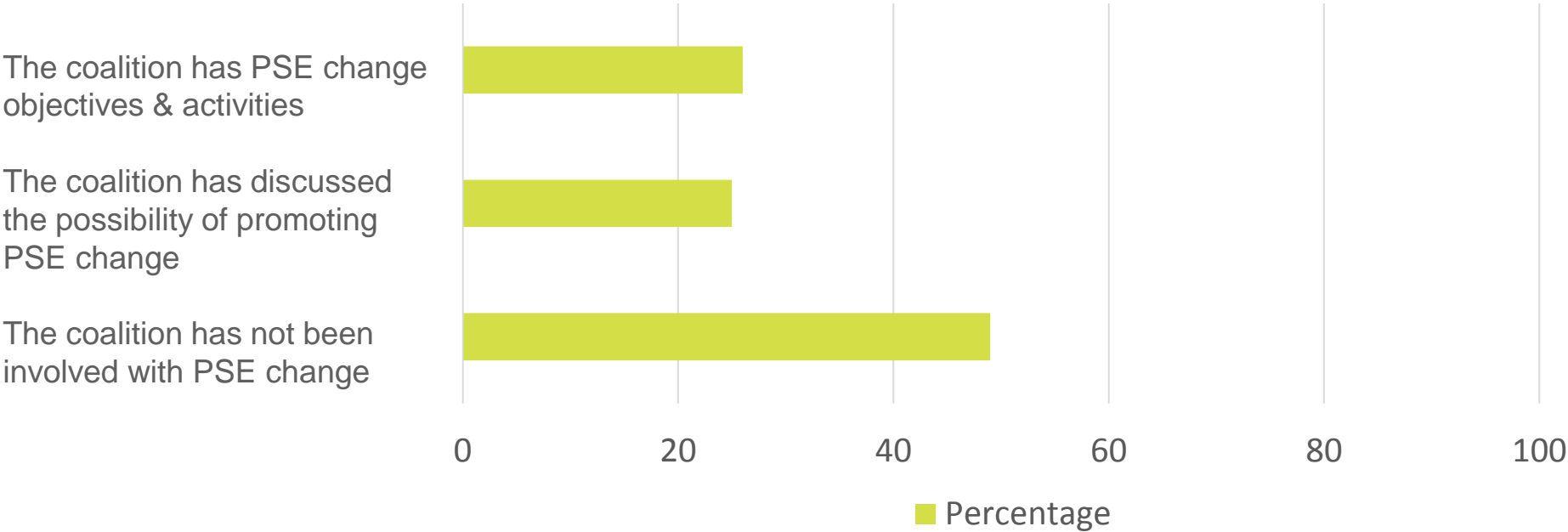
A coalition is a type of **collaboration** consisting of **mutually beneficial and well-defined relationships** among **organizations** that come together to work for a **common goal**.

Are the following examples of PSEC?

1. Hosting a community fun run – **No, this is a one-time event. Complete street interventions would be PSEC.**
2. Adopting a healthy vending policy - **Yes**
3. Adopting healthy meeting guidelines - **Yes**
4. Offering breastfeeding classes for new moms – **No, this is education. Baby friendly hospital interventions would be PSEC.**
5. Offering fall prevention classes for seniors – **No, this is education. Universal design would be a PSEC.**
6. Starting a farm to school program - **Yes**

PSEC Case Study 1: Washington State University Extension

- A track was built around the perimeter of an elementary school
- Nutritious food in one school cafeteria was renamed (i.e. Beast Mode bananas)
- Farm to School “Harvest of the Month” program
- School wellness policy development

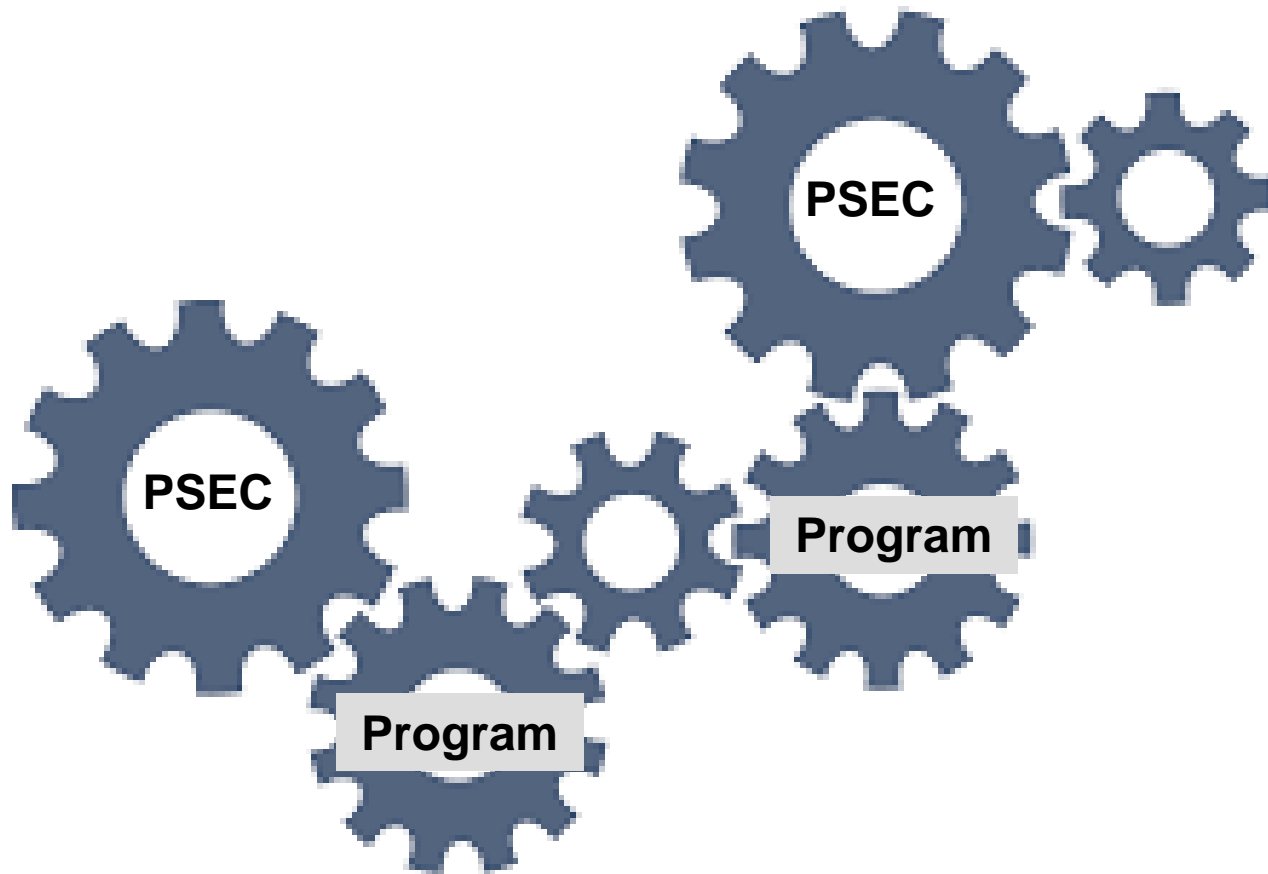


PSEC Case Study 2: University of California Cooperative Extension

- School wellness policy development
 - No SSBs at fundraisers
 - Healthy foods at sporting events
- Healthy meeting guidelines
 - Healthy foods
 - Walking breaks

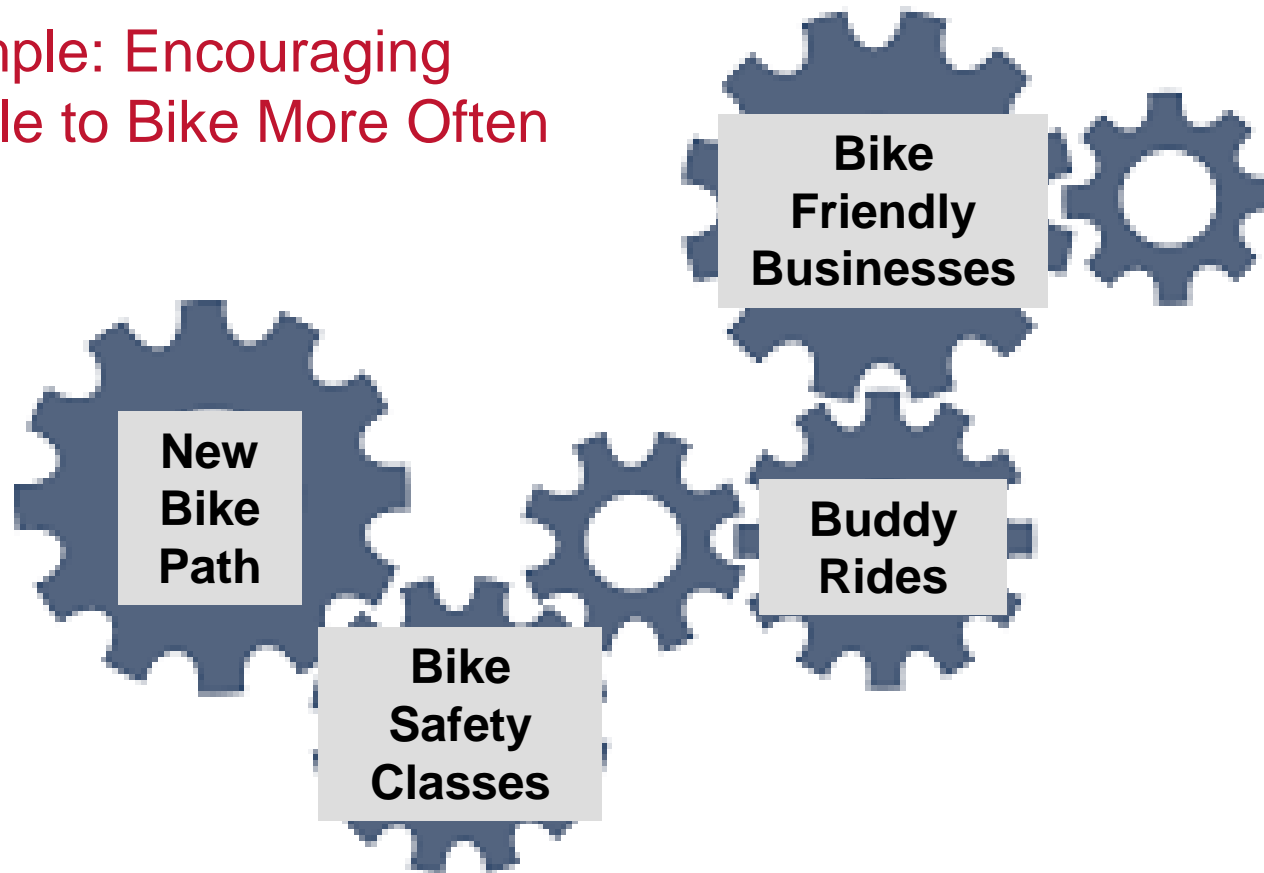

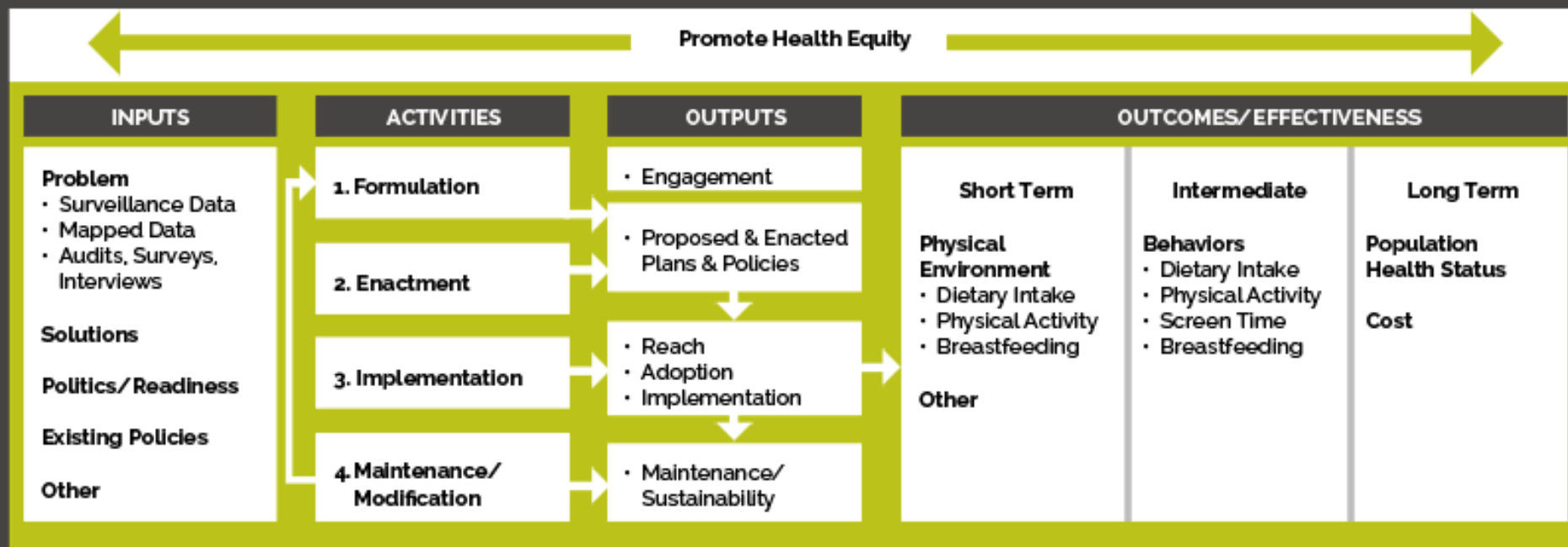
