### **Decoding Food Product Dates**

#### "Sell-By" Date

Tells the store how long a food product should be displayed on the shelves as being for sale.
Buy the product before that date is reached to ensure adequate storage time once purchased





# "Closed" or "Coded" Date A packing number for use by the food manufacturer.

## "Best if Used By" or "Before" Date

A date that is recommended for best flavor or quality. It is not a purchase-by or food safety date.



### "Use By" Date

The last date recommended for product use while at peak quality. The date is determined by the food manufacturer and does not indicate spoilage or safety.



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
